ROAD BOND PROCEDURES

- 1. A letter must be received by the Township from the company requesting to use the road *prior* to any work beginning; the letter must contain the following:
 - a. Contact name, company name, address, and telephone/fax number
 - b. Description of what the road is to be used for
 - c. Road name, location of portion of road to be used, and mileage to be used
 - d. Start and finish dates
- 2. Work cannot be started until the Township verifies the mileage of road to be used.
- 3. Work cannot be started until the company is given permission by the Township. Permission will be granted after the following is received in the Township Office:
 - a. A signed Road Bond Agreement
 - b. A \$50.00 check made out to the Conemaugh Township Supervisors to cover administrative costs
 - c. A check, bond, or irrevocable letter of credit to bond the road per the following rates: (Road bond rates set by Penndot)

1. Paved road = \$12,500.00 per mile 2. Dirt road = \$6,000.00 per mile

- 4. When work is completed, a letter must be sent to the Township stating so.
- 5. After the Township receives a letter stating that the work is completed, the Township will examine the road for any damage that might have occurred.
- 6. If no damage is found, the company's check or bond will be returned to the company along with a letter of release from the Township.
- 7. If damage is found, the company's check or bond will be used to cover damage repairs. The Township will perform its own road repairs. If damage is in excess of the check or bond amount, the company will be responsible to pay the Township for the difference.
